Parents information



Cast

Important information to go back home with a cast

Right positioning :

- Raise the **arm** as often as possible the first days
 Don't let it hang down
- While seating: raise the arm on a pillow
 While standing: use a scarf to sustain the arm
- Move fingers regularly
- While seating: raise the leg on a chair or similar
- While lying down: raise the leg on a pillow without putting pressure on the heel
- Move toes regularly
- Don't lean on the cast

Itching:

• Don't scratch by putting something in the cast in case of itching

Shower/bath/swim:

The cast must <u>never</u> get wet.

- Protect the cast with a plastic bag and seal it hermetically
- Showering with protection is allowed, no bathing or swimming

Discomfort or pain:

In case of pressure, pain, swelling, swarming, skin color change or heat change:

- 1: Raise the limb during 30 minutes
- 2: If there is no change, ask a health professional to control as soon as possible
